



CPS Receiver Set Up

1. Plug in the CPS receiver to an available USB port on your computer. Your receiver will look different based on whether you have CPS IR, or CPS RF *(see pictures).*

- 2. Double-click the CPS desktop icon to open CPS.
- 3. CPS will automatically detect your receiver.
- To verify your receiver is connected:
- 1. Double-click the CPS desktop icon to open CPS.
- 2. Click the elnstruction lcon in the Windows system tray.



3. Select elnstruction Device Manager from the menu.

4. The elnstruction Device Manager window will open. Click the Options menu, then Discover Devices.
