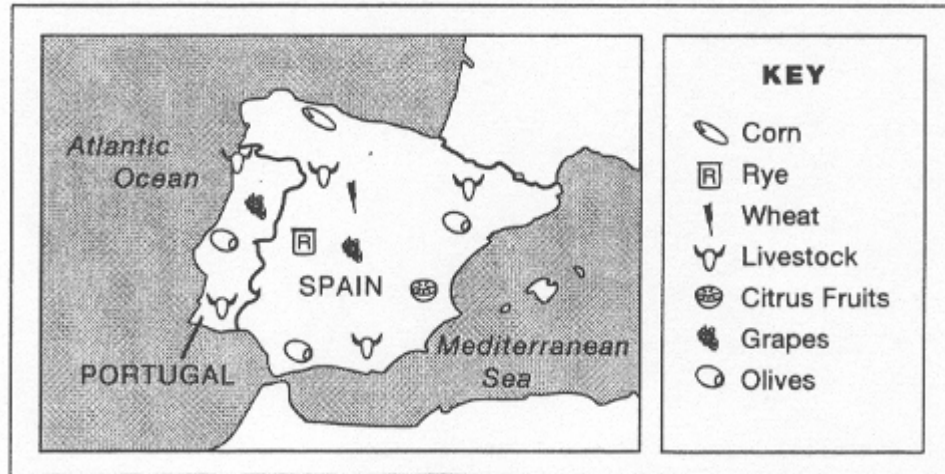


1. Use the map and key below to answer number 1.



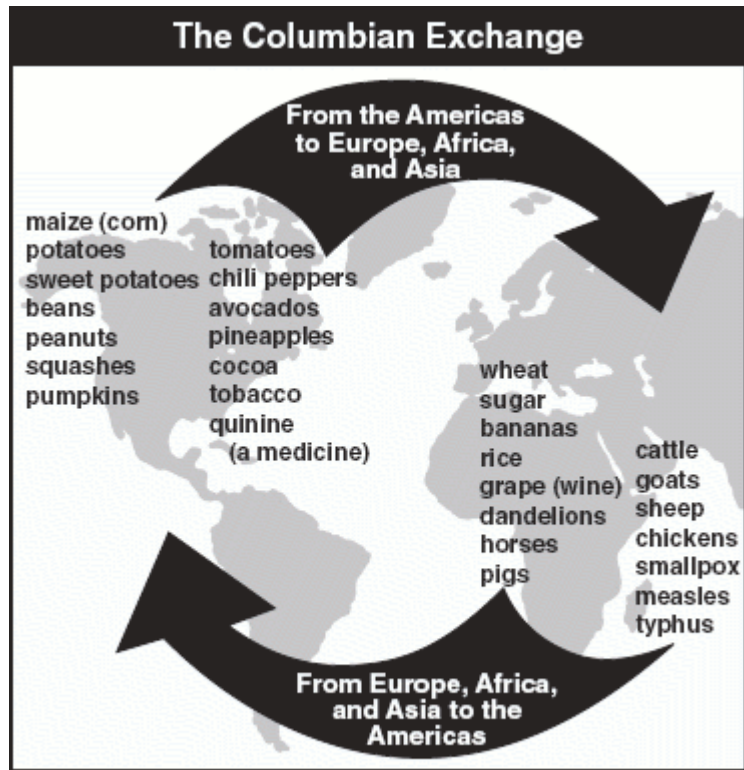
Given the resources of Spain and Portugal, which agricultural products would Portugal most likely import from Spain?

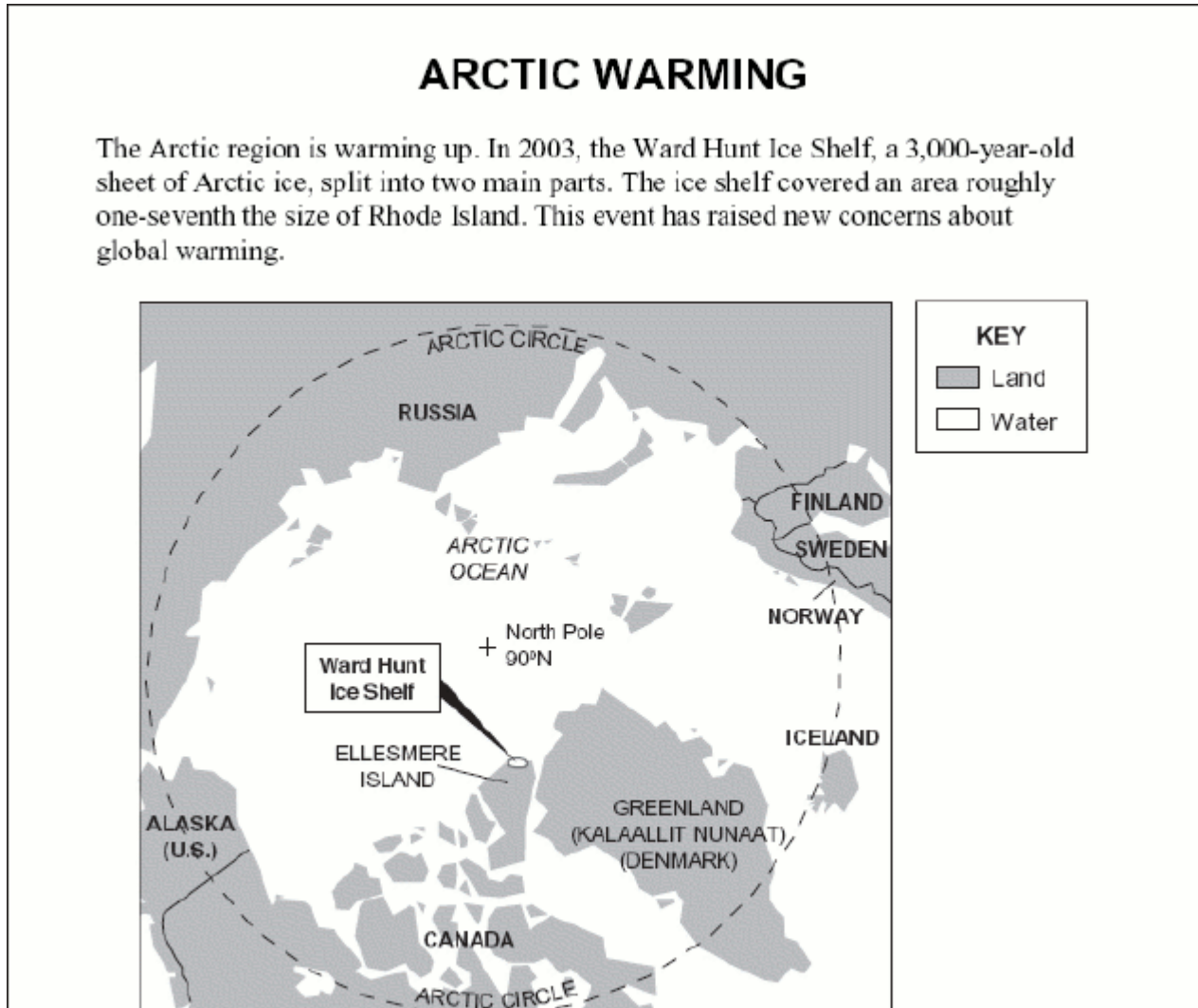
